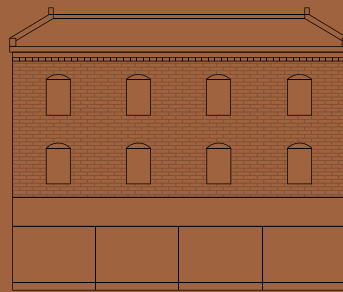
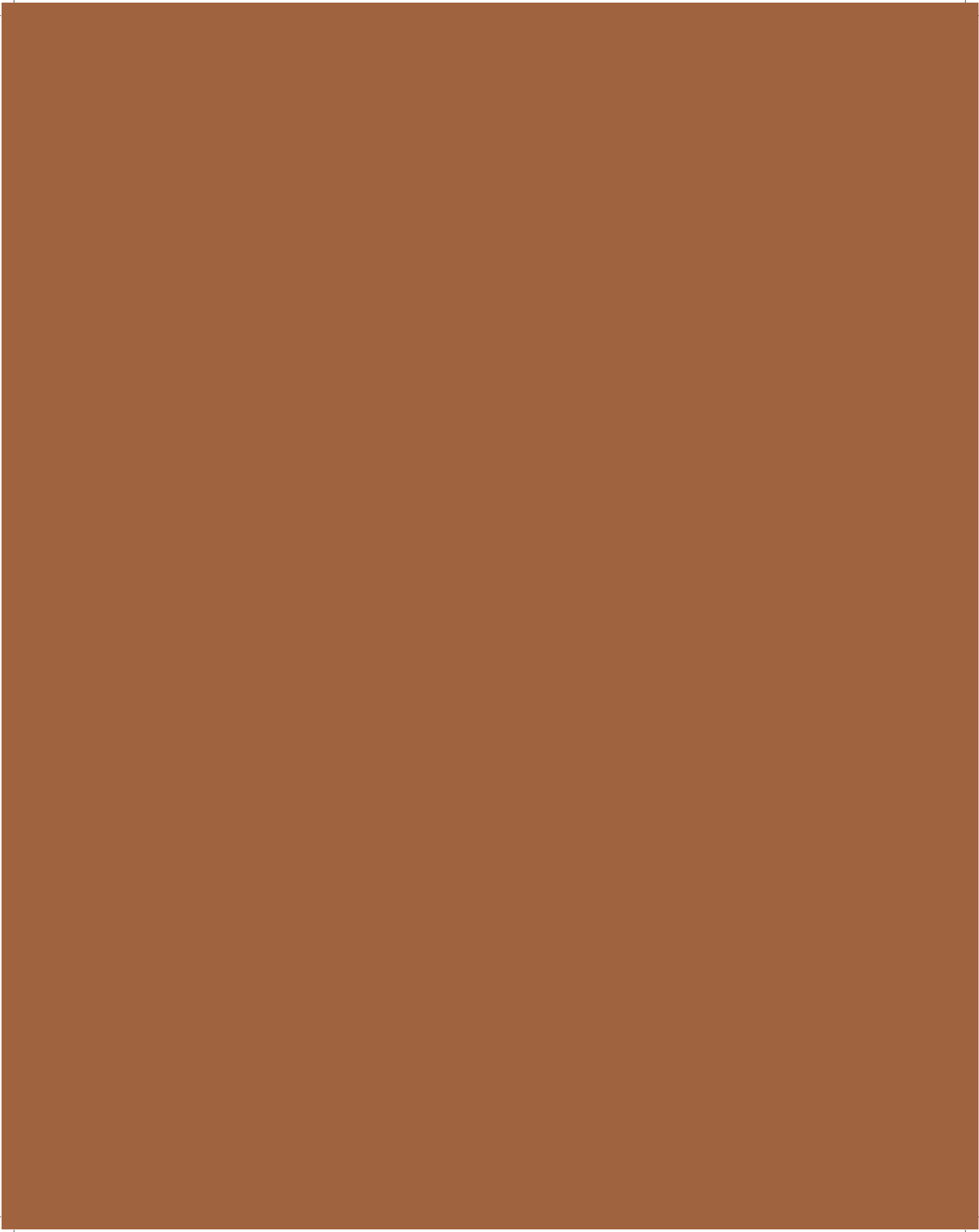

BORN OF BALLET

Life itself is a dance, with each year unfolding to reveal new, ever-increasingly daring moves. Adagio by Menkes pays tribute to the esteemed history of the 148-year-old building at 771 Yonge Street. There, Boris Volkoff, the famed Russian-born dancer, choreographer, director and teacher trained talented ballet dancers from 1930 to 1945. Revered as the “father of Canadian ballet,” Volkoff went on to co-found the National Ballet of Canada, and worked on co-productions with the Toronto Opera Company — today’s Canadian Opera Company.

THE DANCE OF TIME

Amid the excitement of creating the new Village of Yorkville in 1872, entrepreneurial couple Elizabeth and Joseph French built a three-storey hotel at 771 Yonge St. This architectural treasure still stands, and will be preserved and integrated into the new structure of Adagio.

Anchored by the iconic Hudson's Bay Company, the intersection of Yonge and Bloor is becoming ever more exhilarating, with new additions enhancing the streetscape. PERFECT GREEN OASES

While Adagio is located in a lively downtown neighbourhood, it's also close to sprawling parkland you can easily walk to. Just steps along Park Road is Lawren Harris Park, on the edge of the majestic Rosedale Ravine. Boasting 13.7 acres of open space, Ramsden Park is one of the largest parks in downtown Toronto. Tennis courts, a skating rink, shady mature trees, walking trails, green grass and plenty of outdoor seating make this park a welcome oasis.

Yonge and Bloor is a major transit hub where the subway lines 1 and 2 meet, and from there you can access any part of the GTA and beyond. Connect to Union Station in just 11 minutes, and catch the UP Express train to Pearson Airport. This neighbourhood has a walk score of 99, meaning it's fantastic for getting around on foot. Bike share and car share programs can easily be found in this neighbourhood, so there's never any need for a car.

GET THERE IN 10 MINUTES OR LESS

From Adagio, you can access a range of premium amenities within minutes, on foot or by subway. Residents can enjoy a 1 minute walk to Bloor-Yonge Station, with the boutique shops, cafes and bistros of Yorkville all within walking distance.

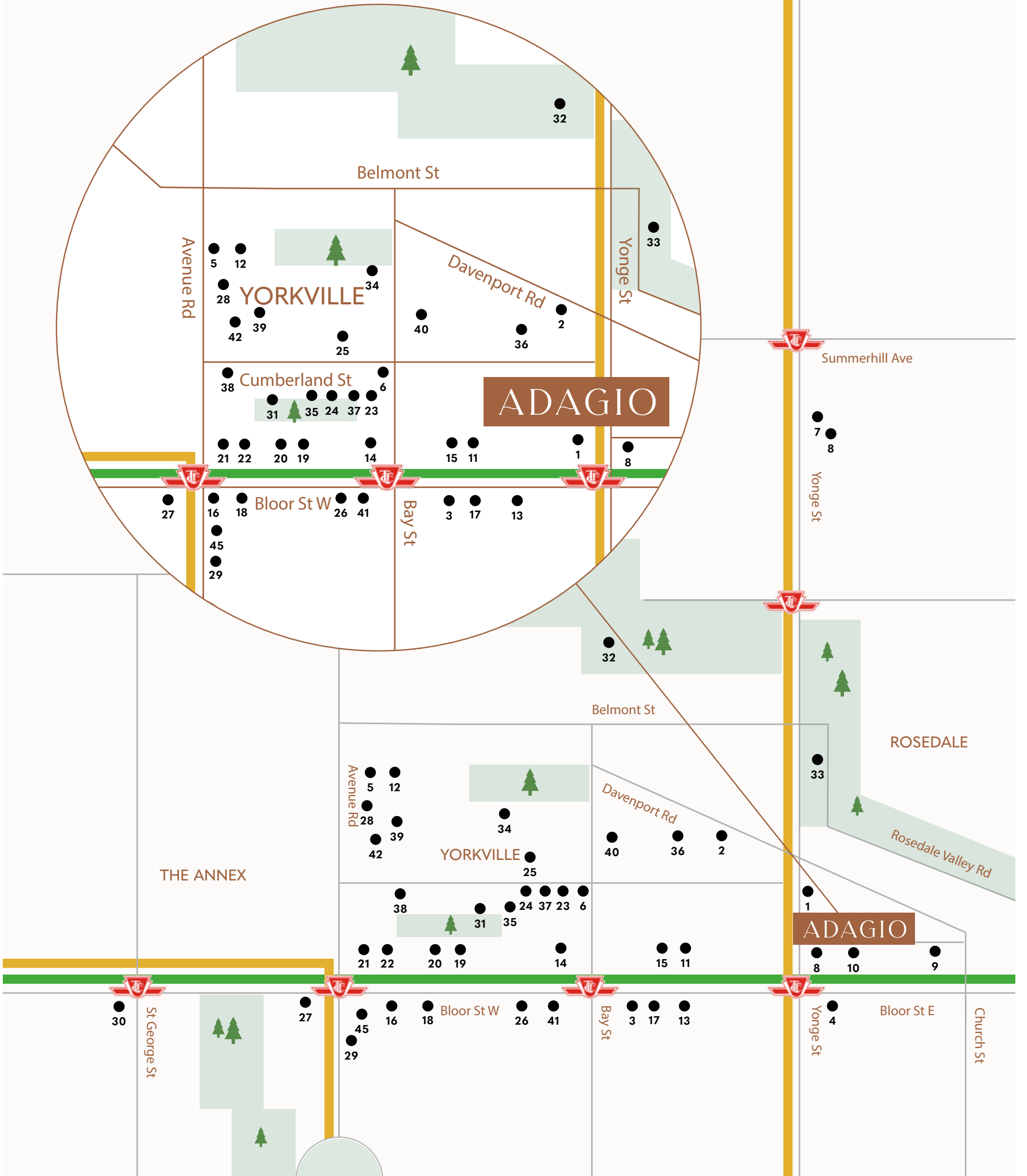

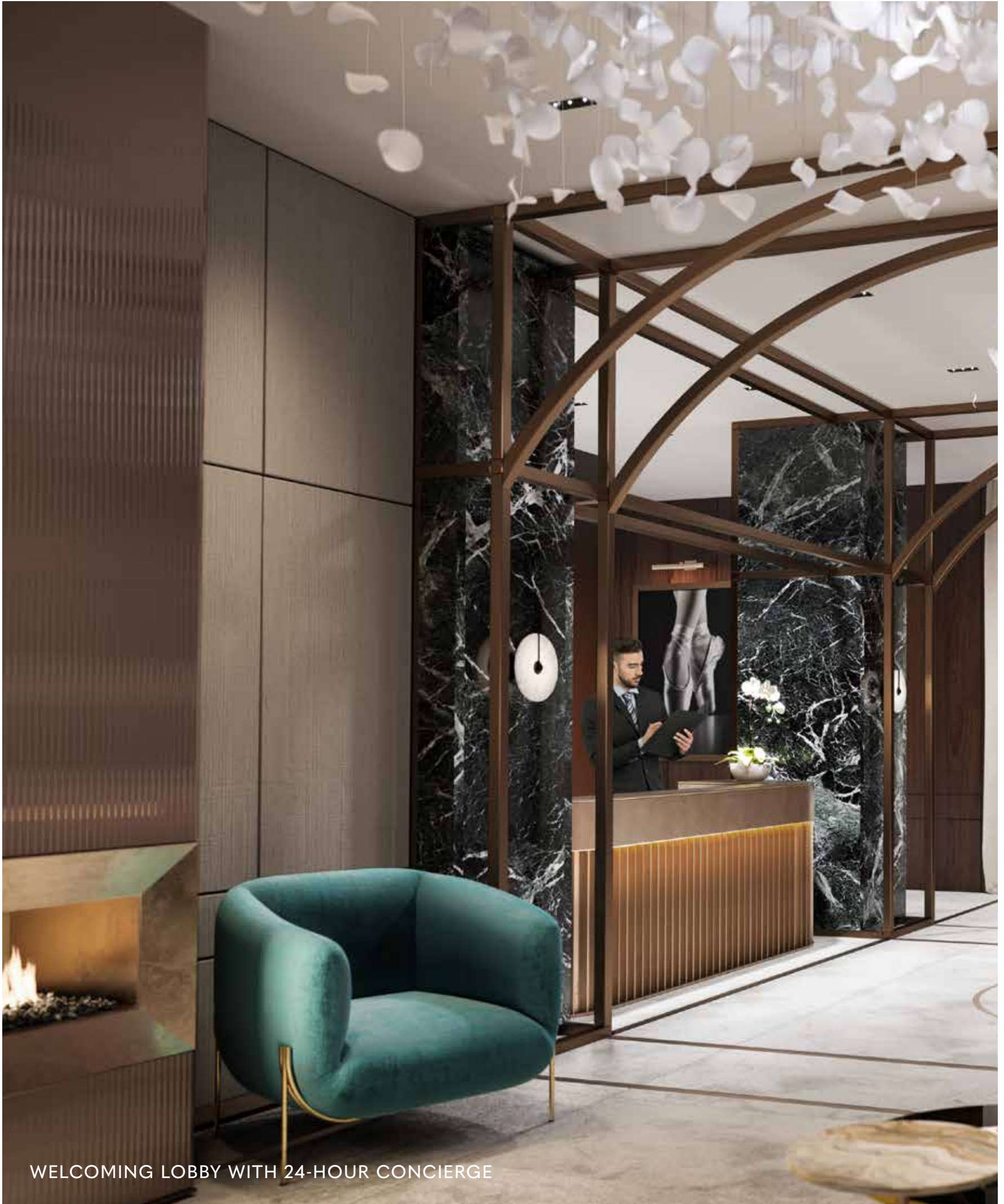


WELCOMING LOBBY WITH 24-HOUR CONCIERGE
